NIH Implementation of Final Research Performance Progress Reports (Final RPPR)

The National Institutes of Health has announced that the Final Progress Report (FPR) will be replaced with the Final Research Performance Progress Report (Final RPPR) through a new eRA Commons module effective **January 2017**. On or after that date, NIH will no longer accept FPRs.
